Define the problem.
What is your goal?

IF unsure when driving, STOP: check the map.

IF unsure when deciding, STOP: compare options, pros cons.

TEST the thought. BB. Truth/God says...

TEST the action. BB. IF → THEN → THEN +pros. -cons.

IF I do This THEN (short-term) THEN (long-term): +pros. -cons.

IF I do That THEN (short-term) THEN (long-term): +pros. -cons.
